

Fridge Depths

Base cabinets tend to be a standard depth of 24" but fridges do not. Please consider what your preference is when purchasing a fridge. All cabinets below have the same depths but as you can see the fridges do not.



STANDARD DEPTH FRIDGE:

Usually 35" or 36" total depth with doors/handles. The doors/handles and part of the fridge will protrude from the cabinet.



COUNTER DEPTH FRIDGE:

Usually 33" total depth with doors/handles. Only the doors/handles protrude from the cabinet.



INTEGRATED PANEL FRIDGE:

Usually 24" total depth plus handles, only the handles protrude from the cabinet. Integrated Panel allows for a cabinet panel to be applied to blend with existing cabinets.



FLUSH MOUNT FRIDGE:

Usually 24" total depth plus handles, only the handles protrude from the cabinet. These types of fridges tend to have compressors on the top.
